BORDER

- Improve and integrate electronic database within the RTP and outside (domestically and internationally)
e.g. I24-7, POLIS, CRIMES, PIBICS
- Amendment of Immigration regulations to conform with ASEAN Charter
- Renovate and improve border control infrastructure
- Modernizing information technology for border control e.g. database, E-Fingerprint
- Capacity Building for border control and related officers

ORGANIZATION

- Reform of Organization
- Improvement of information technology, forensic science capacity
- Language efficiency (English and ASEAN)
- Cultural diversity education
- Human rights

CONNECTIVITY

- Update road regulations and law enforcement procedures to conform with international standard (tickets in English and procedure of paying fine etc.)
- Establish more check points
- Preparing for safety measures in international train, airports and maritime routes
- Improve safety for tourists (increase help network and interpreters post in police stations)
